- Price:** Prices are listed – all materials included in price
- Class Size:** Size varies upon store location
- Registration:** Please sign up at the Service Desk
- Payment:** Your place in the class is reserved by full payment plus tax when you sign up.
- Tools needed:** You must bring **ONE PAIR OF 7" DIAGONAL WIRE CUTTERS.** Do not bring needle-nose pliers, regular pliers or small wire cutters – they will not cut through stems. You can purchase 7" wire cutters at Sears, Lowes, Home Depot, Wal-Mart, Hardware Stores or Harbor Freight. Be sure they are 7" diagonal or longer. You will also need one pair of scissors, one knife to cut Styrofoam (larger than a paring knife, but smaller than a butcher knife)
- Time:** Please be on time for the class scheduled – the earlier you come, the better choice of seats you will have!

Cancellations

The seating is on a first come, first serve basis. Since the demand is high for these classes, if you cancel your reservation or fail to be present, you automatically forfeit one-half cost of the class. Since this is a special savings with class participation only, you also forfeit all items provided by Ellis Pottery. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Saturday March 3rd "Formal Spring Floral Grapevine Wreath"

Class Hours: 9am - 12pm

Cost: \$50

Sign up soon, as these fill up very quickly! This is a great design to greet the spring season. You will decorate on an 18" oval grapevine wreath in an elongated crescent design. The colors will be in shades of spring; pink, yellow, purple, white, lavender and green. It will be formal with great curb appeal. It will usher in spring with a full, but airy look. You will have floral and greenery provided for you and you will select some of your own unique pieces. No bow will be required. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have a piece valued at \$100)

Saturday March 3rd "Spring Mesh Work Wreath"

Class Hours: 1pm - 4pm

Cost: \$45

Sign up for the ever popular mesh work wreath. This is the "hit of the season". You will have a Spring theme in colors of your choice possibly lime green, pink, yellow, lavender, white, etc. You will be taught how to put the mesh onto the work wreath form. Then you will select your color of mesh from our entire stock available. Then you will weave your mesh into your wreath. Next you will go into the store and select \$70.00 worth of merchandise from the floor of your choice to place into your wreath. You may choose anything you want. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90)

Wednesday March 7th "Combo Class Spring Garden Pot w/ Accent Bouquets" **New Class!!**

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm

Cost: \$50

This is a combination class of a beautiful Spring arrangement in a garden pot. You will have all florals in yellows, green, pinks, lime greens, lavenders, and whites. Next you will make accent presentation bouquets of matching florals. These can be used to decorate by laying them on tables in any room of the home, placing them by lamps, in a bookcase, or a mantle, in the kitchen area, even by the sink in the bath. You can never have enough to spread around to bring that "breath" of Spring indoors. Bring knife, wire cutters & scissors. (You will have a piece valued at \$100)

Saturday March 10th "Easter Bunny & Friends Wreath"

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$45

Here comes Peter Cottontail hopping down the bunny trail and on to your front door! This will be a combination Easter/Spring wreath more on the whimsical side. It will have Easter novelties, grasses, florals in spring colors and accent pieces perfect for the season. You will be allowed to choose some extra items to make yours uniquely your own. Bring wire cutters & scissors. (You will have a piece valued at \$90)

Saturday March 10th "Easter Centerpiece"

Class Hours: 1pm – 4pm
Cost: \$45

Peter Cottontail hopped down the trail and ended up waiting for you in this cute Easter centerpiece. You will have a companion piece to go along with your Easter wreath. This will be designed in a whimsical spring planter container with Easter novelties, spring florals, Easter eggs and grasses. Fun piece to use all spring. Bring a knife, wire cutters, and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90.)

Sunday March 11th "Ribbon Class–Bow Tying for Beginners I"

Class Hours: 2pm – 5pm
Cost: \$25

You will learn how to tie bows by hand. Previous knowledge of bow tying is not required. You will learn how to tie one, three, five, and seven loop bows. You will practice on cotton, grosgrain, satin and other types of material. You will also practice with different widths of wired and unwired ribbon. You will keep all of your practice ribbon. At the end of the class, you will get to choose one roll of ribbon for \$10 or less to make a large bow. You will never have to pay another labor charge, because now you can tie beautiful bows yourself! Bring one pair of scissors.

Saturday March 17th "Spring Mesh Garland" **HOT NEW CLASS!**

This is the same concept as the mesh wreath except in a garland style. You will take a 9 foot work garland and learn how to entwine

the mesh throughout. One garland will take 2 rolls of mesh. You may choose 1 color or 2 colors of mesh depending on your preference. After you have placed your mesh – you will be able to select your choice of silk florals, berries, greenery, or any accent pieces from our entire store. You will have \$65.00 to choose on your materials to make your garland uniquely yours. This piece is perfect for above the front door, down the table as a runner, or the mantle or as an accent piece anywhere in the home. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$100.)

Saturday March 17th "Spring Fling Centerpiece"

Class Hours: 1pm – 4pm
Cost: \$45

You will have your choice of a select group of "fun" Spring containers. You will use a mixture of hot, bright Spring colors in yellow, pink, lavender, lime green and white to fill the container. This will be a fun, whimsical class. Great accent piece for porch, patio, kitchen, kid's room or by the hearth to bring a splash of Spring inside. Bring wire cutters, knife, and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90.)

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$50

The stately and beautiful heirloom hydrangea will be placed upon a 24" round grapevine wreath. You will add light and airy greenery such as asparagus fern, berries, ivy, and more to complete. You will have your choice of colors in accent florals. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$100)

Wednesday March 28th "Create Your Own Mesh Wreath"

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$45

You will be the designer on this one. You will choose your color of mesh from our entire stock. You will then learn how to apply your

mesh to your work wreath. Then you will have \$70 to go onto the floor to spend in selecting exactly what you want to put onto your wreath. You can do anything at all in any theme you want – maybe a LSU wreath, a baby wreath, a Saints wreath, a Spring wreath – just any theme you want. Let your mind and your creativity wander. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90)

Saturday March 31st "Create Your Own Grapevine Wreath"

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$50

You will choose any size grapevine wreath, any shape to use as a base for this beauty. You will have \$100 to spend on your wreath to decorate it minus the cost of the grapevine wreath. You can do greenery, florals –whatever you want. You may wish to make it for your front door, over the mantle, or inside the home. The choice, the colors, the size and the theme are your own personal choice. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$100.)

Sunday April 1st "Ribbon Class Intermediate/Advanced Bow Tying"

Class Hours: 2pm – 5pm
Cost: \$30

YOU MUST KNOW HOW TO TIE A BOW BEFORE YOU TAKE THIS ADVANCED CLASS.

This is an accelerated bow tying class and the basics will NOT be taught. In this class you will learn how to do stacked, overlaid, and layered bows. After this lesson, a bow with one ribbon will seem boring! You will also tie a bow with florals in the loops of the bow at the end of the class. This bow can serve as a centerpiece, or be put on a basket or candlestick. You will choose one bolt of ribbon (\$10 or less) and florals of your choice (up to \$15). All the bows you tie in the class will be yours to keep. Bring wire cutters and scissors.

Saturday April 7th "Formal Design Dining Room Centerpiece"
NEW CLASS

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$75

If you need a formal dining table centerpiece, this is the class for you. We have all new designer stems in our floral dept.- fresh from the Dallas Market for you to choose from. You will have an elongated and 4 sided designer container. Greenery will be provided for you as well as neutrals. You will select your own colors. This will not be a compact centerpiece – but rather airy and loose. It will be beautiful and compliment any dining table. Bring wire cutters, scissors and a knife. (You will have an item valued at \$150)

Saturday April 7th "Spring Mesh Mantlepiece"
New Class!!

Class Hours: 1pm – 12pm
Cost: \$40

This is a new design for the top of your mantle. It will be done on a 9 ft. work garland using mesh. You will use one roll of mesh of your choice of color. You will then double the length to make a 4 ½ ft. long piece. Then you will choose your florals in your choice of Spring colors to place in this piece. You may also add accessory pieces of your choice to finish. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have and item valued at \$80.)

Wednesday April 11th "Stacked Greenery Arrangement"
New Class!!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$40

This is a relatively new design. It will be layering or levels of mixed greeneries. It will be a three sided piece starting with your tallest level and working your way down to the lowest level. Assortments of various greeneries will be used. It is quite different and can be placed against a wall, in a foyer, on a bookcase or in the fireplace in

the summer. Bring wire cutters, scissors, and a knife. (You will have an item valued at \$80)

Saturday April 14th "Memorial Cemetery Saddle Monument Piece"

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$40

This class is a memorial tribute piece to be used at the cemetery to attach in the form of a "saddle" or cradle on top of the monument. You will learn the mechanics of constructing the Styrofoam on the "saddle" form. You may choose any colors you want. Remember to spray all cemetery pieces with 2 coats of Scotch Guard spray – it will keep your colors from fading twice as long. Bring scissors and wire cutters. (You will have a \$80 value)

Saturday April 14th "Memorial Cemetery Vase Insert or Pronged Can"

Class Hours: 1pm – 4pm
Cost: \$40

This class is a memorial tribute piece to be used at the cemetery in an attached vase on the monument or to be made in a can with built in prongs to go into the ground. You will learn how to do a round design with your choice of bushes in florals and greeneries. Bring wire cutters and scissors. Remember – if you spray your piece with Scotch Guard, let it dry for five minutes and spray it again; your cemetery piece will retain the color twice as long without fading. Great for outdoor wreaths, too. Try it – you will be surprised! Bring wire cutters, knife and scissors. (You will have a \$80 value)

Sunday April 15th "Ribbon Class - Bow Tying For Beginners II"

Class Hours: 2pm – 5pm
Cost: \$25

This is a repeat class due to the high demand of our customers. The description is the same as the class listed on Sunday, March 11th. See previous description.

Wednesday April 18th "3 Sided Flat Back Formal Foyer Piece"
New Class!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$40

You will be allowed to select your own container – your personal choice. The design will be 3 sided with a flat back and slightly flowing forward and down the front. You will have your choice of

focal flowers in your choice of color. Greenery and neutral fillers will be provided for you. Bring a knife, scissors and wire cutters. (You will have a \$80 value)

Saturday April 21st "Deluxe Magnolia Grapevine Wreath"
NEW CLASS!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$45

This Southern beauty will be created on an 18" oval grapevine wreath. The magnolias and greenery will be selected for you and you will be able to choose your accent florals in your choice of colors and style of flowers. This will be a dressy elongated crescent design and perfect to capture that Southern charm in your décor. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90)

Saturday April 28th "Buffet Table Lamp Centerpiece"
Popular Class! Unique Centerpiece!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$50

Back by popular demand. You will never have too many of these in your home. You will take a buffet table lamp and turn it into a unique centerpiece for your home. You may use it on a sofa table, end table, night stand or foyer table. You will take a neutral colored lamp shade or wrought iron candlestick lamp and sit it atop a footed tray with handles. Then you will decorate around the base of the lamp into the tray itself. Greeneries will be provided for you and you will select your own silk florals and colors. This is a great centerpiece to keep or give as a gift for a wedding, birthday, or just because. Bring wire cutters, a knife and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$100.)

Saturday April 28th "Trunk Table Arrangement"

Class Hours: 1pm – 4pm
Cost: \$45

This is a popular piece-the classic trunk arrangement. You will be able to choose from the flat top trunk or domed lid top trunk. You may do florals, greeneries, or a combination. You will be able to select your choice. This will be a three sided piece with a somewhat flat back-perfect to go against a wall area, on a foyer table, shelf, or on top of an armoire. Bring a knife, scissors and wire cutters. (You will have a \$90 value.)

Wednesday May 2nd "Candle Cluster Arrangement"
New Class!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$40

This is a collection of candles in different sizes, shapes, fragrances all of which you will choose yourself. You will combine these in a group and place neutral color flowers and greeneries around to complete your special centerpiece. It will be fragrant as well as beautiful. Bring a knife, wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$80.)

Saturday May 5th "Wrought Iron Wall Pocket or Sconce Hanger"

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$45

You will take a very popular wrought iron wall pocket container and fill with grasses, greeneries, and florals to make a luxurious floral piece fitting for any wall space in the home or even to use on the front door as a change from using a wreath. You will be able to choose your florals. Grasses and greeneries will be provided for you. Bring a knife, scissors and wire cutters. (You will have a \$90 value.)

Saturday May 5th "Waterfall Table Fountain Centerpiece with Greenery"

Class Hours: 1pm – 4pm
Cost: \$50

You will take a tabletop fountain and place it in a Malaysian saucer. The saucer is 14" in diameter. You will have your choice of mixed greeneries to give it that lush, fresh garden look. This is a combination water fountain/greenery class. Bring a knife, scissors and wire cutters. (You will have a \$100 value.)

The "hit" design of last summer has come back to the forefront again. You will take three huge yellow sunflowers and design elongated crescent design on an 18" oval grapevine wreath. You will add summer grasses and trailing airplane plants. This is a design for those hot months ahead and quite an eye catcher for your front door. You will have accent novelties of your choice including seed packets and gardener's items. Fun Summer Wreath! Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90.)

Saturday May 26th "Summer Sunflower Hanging Basket"
New Class!!

Cost: \$60

This is a companion piece to go with the Sunflower Wreath Class – or it can stand on its own. It will be a huge hanging basket of sunflowers and greenery with your choice of fillers. You will take a wire basket with a coco liner, add Styrofoam and Spanish moss. The sunflowers inside will be large and very showy. This piece will be the focal point of the patio or porch. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$120.)

Wednesday May 30th “Summer Sunflower Clay Pot Arrangement”
New Class!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$45

You will have another companion piece to the classes listed above. This class will use large sunflowers and group them in a large terra cotta clay pot. You will have a greenery mix and your choice of fillers. Another great piece for the dining area outside, the porch, patio or by the door. Great summer arrangement for those hot 110☀☀☀☀° days! Bring wire cutters, a knife, and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$90.)

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm

Have you ever wanted to learn how to make your own hair bows and not pay that high price some places charge? This is the class for you! You will learn the basic techniques of simple – one layer hair bows. You will use different ribbons in different widths. Bring wire cutters and scissors.

Saturday March 10th "Easter Bunny Mesh Wreath"
New Class!!

Class Hours: 1pm – 4pm
Cost: \$60

Peter Cottontail wants to jump onto this mesh wreath and go home with you! You will have your choice of mesh garland – any color you want. You will have an Easter Bunny selected for you and you will be taught how to put the mesh on the work wreath and the bunny on it. Then you will be able to shop the store for all of your accessory pieces that will make yours unique. Bring wire cutters and scissors. (You will have an item valued at \$120.)

Saturday April 7th "Fresh Plant Combination Hanging Basket"
New Garden Class!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$35

You will take a wire basket with a coco liner insert and fill it with an 8 qt. bag of Miracle Grow potting mix. You will then decide if your spot to hang your basket will require sun or shade plants. You will choose your plants from our entire garden center to plant your basket. Accessory items will be included to finish your basket, such as fertilizer, sphagnum moss, etc. (You will have an item valued at \$70.)

Saturday April 14th "Fresh Plant European Terra Cotta Clay Pot Combination"
New Garden Class!!

Class Hours: 9am – 12pm
Cost: \$45

You will take a 15" terra cotta clay pot and fill it with Miracle Gro potting mix. You will have your selection of annuals (plants to be planted every year) to fill your pot. Before selecting, know if you will place it in the sun or shade. You will place the pot in the terra cotta matching saucer for water overflow. You will finish with garden accessory pieces, fertilizer, or sphagnum moss. (You will have an item valued at \$90.)
